WORSHIP Today, 10 AM and 5 PM

Morning worship: Today we celebrate the sacrament of baptism for Sevan Price and Rowan Wierenga. As these little ones are baptized, we celebrate what God's covenant promises in baptism mean for the whole Christian community as we begin a sermon series on "Remembering Baptism." The series begins with Rev. Rebecca Jordan Heys preaching from Galatians 3:26-29, "Remember Who You Are." We welcome Cassandra Kroondyk to lead in ministry of music. Cassandra Kroondyk teaches violin at the String Academy of Grand Rapids and is a Chanter at Holy Trinity Greek Orthodox Church.

Evening worship: Rev. Laura Smit preaches from Genesis 3:1-19, "The Mystery of Sin."

WORSHIP Next Sunday, July 7

Morning worship: We will continue our series on remembering baptism as Rev. Rebecca Jordan Heys will preach from Ephesians 4:1-16, "Remember Where You Belong." We will celebrate the sacrament of the Lord's Supper, and Paul Herrema will lead us in ministry of music. The offering will be for 70x7.

Evening worship: We host the congregations of Woodlawn and Plymouth Heights Christian Reformed Churches. Rev. Brad Zwiers will preach from 2 Kings 5:1-19, and the offering will be for the Baxter Community Center.

Sermon Series: Our morning worship series on remembering baptism is adapted from an idea in *Reformed Worship* 132 by Rev. Joyce Borger. On Sunday, July 14, Rev. Brad Zwiers will preach from Romans 6:1-11, "Remember What You Have," and on Sunday, July 21, Rev. Rebecca Jordan Heys will preach from Colossians 3:1-17, "Remember How to Live."

COUNCIL NEWS

We now celebrate the Lord's Supper 18 times each year: 12 times during AM services and 6 times during PM services. Traditionally there has been a benevolence offering following any communion, in addition to the community care or ministry fund offering also taking place that service. The deacons have decided to continue the pattern of receiving a benevolence offering following communion 12 times a year, with those 12 times being the AM services. There will no longer be a separate benevolence offering for evening communion services, so those who wish to still respond to communion with a benevolence gift in a PM service may do so by marking an envelope for the benevolence fund and dropping it in the offering plate.
